Kindness Habitat Story

- in God wants us to live in a beautiful habitat, a place where all feel loved, safe and whole. And God calls us to be partners in that creation.
- Jesus says that this amazing place exists on earth every day. He calls it the kingdom of heaven making us think at first it must be far away. But Jesus says that kingdom is right now and he uses ordinary things in life and nature to help us see the special kindness of God.
- ♠ In one story Jesus uses a tiny seed to say, look, this tiny seed may look like nothing. But when an ordinary person plants it, it becomes something else a big bush, even a tree! And not only that, it becomes a nesting ground for flocks of birds!
- God's kindness is planted in us and in the world. Some days that is easy to believe. Other days we need help and reminders. Across a sacred season called Lent we are invited to do some practices that can help us be more aware of the kindness of God and how we nurture that seed.
- Another story in the Bible describes a tiny mustard seed. It says that this small thing that we might ignore or neglect is actually a source for something powerful. It can even move a mountain! This gives us hope and training in paying attention to small things. This is called having faith.
- Turing Lent, Holy Week and Easter we will read stories, do prayer practices and grow in faith together. We will learn more about being God's workers creating a Kindness Habitat in the world.
